

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

KAWASAKI MEDICAL JOURNAL is an official scientific periodical of the Kawasaki Medical Society. One volume published each year is composed of four numbers.

The findings and opinions in the JOURNAL are solely the responsibility of the authors. All manuscripts submitted for publication should be addressed to the Managing Editor of the KAWASAKI MEDICAL JOURNAL, Kawasaki Medical School, Kurashiki 701-0192, Japan. Members of the Kawasaki Medical Society are eligible for the submission of the manuscript to this Journal.

Manuscripts may be written in either English, French or German. The manuscripts should be typewritten, double-spaced, and with good margins, on one side of $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$ inch paper (not on thin paper) and the original and two copies of the manuscript should be submitted. Page 1 should contain the article title, the name(s) of the author(s), affiliation, a running head not exceeding 6 words, and the name and mailing address of the person to whom correspondence should be sent. Page 2 should contain an abstract not exceeding 200 words. Immediately following the abstract not more than 5 English key words should be supplied for subject indexing.

All figures (not larger than 8×10 inches) must be sufficiently clean to permit the making of engraver's cuts without retouching and to allow reduction to one third of the size. Drawings and charts should be made in black but not in blue. All photographs and drawings intended for illustration should be numbered, the top plainly indicated, and the running title of the paper and the name of the author placed on the back of each one.

Legends should be typed on a separate sheet and numbered consecutively. For photomicrographs, the staining method and magnification should be always given.

Tables should be typewritten on separate sheets, numbered in Arabic numerals, and should have a brief descriptive title.

Numerals should be used for all definite weights, measurements, percentages and degrees of temperature. The forms to be used are: l, dl, ml, kg, g, mg, μ g, ng, m, cm, mm, μ m, nm, hr, min and sec. Per cent should be written out in the text.

References should be grouped and numbered at the end of the manuscript according to the order cited in the text and include the following information in the order indicated: Name of the author with initials, title of the article (preferably), name of the periodicals, volume, page and year. They should conform to the following style.
